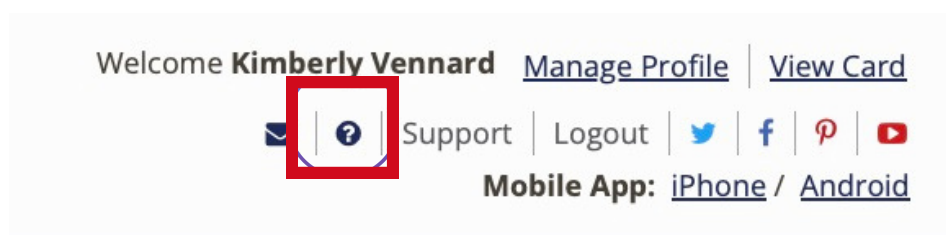

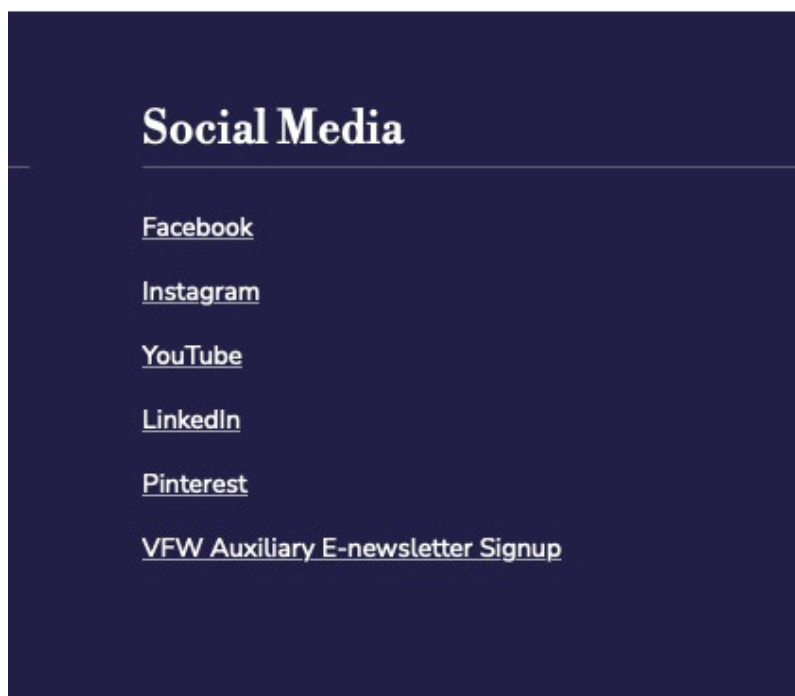
Since there are no January General Orders, we felt it was important to highlight information from the National VFW Auxiliary eNewsletter from January.

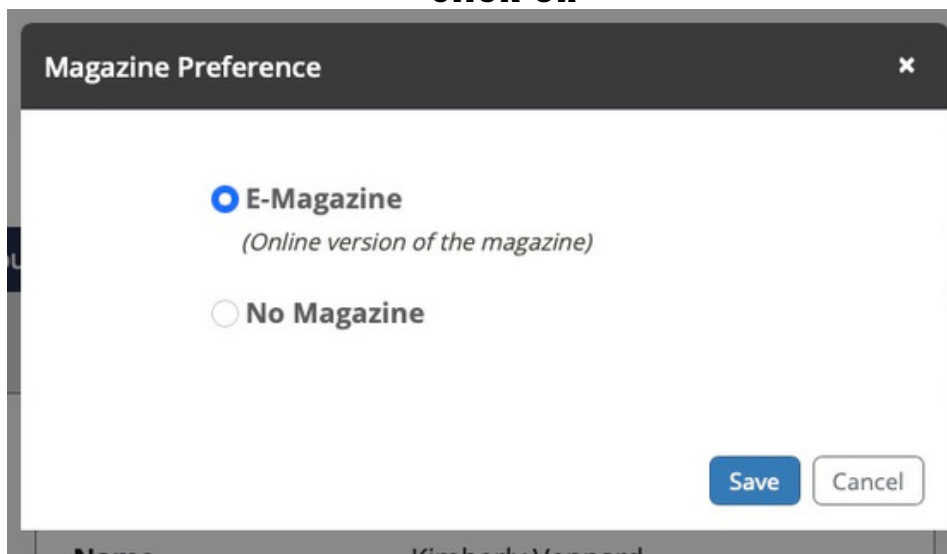

There are many important days and deadlines coming up in January, February and March. Update or note these dates on your own calendars.

January is Mental Wellness Awareness Month, National Blood Donor Month, and Cervical Cancer Awareness Month.

Note: VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters is CLOSED on Monday, January 19, in observance of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

February is Black History Month, American Heart Month, National Cancer Prevention Month and National Chocolate Month.

Salute to Veteran Patients Week will be observed from February 9th to February 15th. Plan a visit to your local VA!

February 15 is the deadline for entrants to submit applications to HQ for the VFW Auxiliary's Continuing Education Scholarship. Remember, this is National President Lois Callahan's special project this year, so please work extra hard to raise both awareness of this scholarship and funds for the future!

Note: VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters is CLOSED on Monday, February 16, in observance of Presidents Day.

March is Women's History Month, Brain Injury Awareness Month, Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month, Red Cross Month, Irish-American Heritage Month and the start of spring.

MARCH 31 is the deadline for student entries to participating/sponsoring Auxiliaries for the following:

NEW APPLICATIONS IN USE NOW
And a New Way to Pay Your Dues!

As it is now 2026, old applications will no longer be accepted. Please do not continue to use old applications for new or transferring members. Previous applications, if filled out and sent in, will be swiftly returned. The new applications, which include a Revised Date, are available to order right now or you can find them in MALTA under Member Resources.

As discussed by National Secretary-Treasurer Ann Panteleakos, National Director of Administrative Services Cortina Barnes and National President Lois Callahan in the December episode of HQ Roundtable on Facebook Live (starting at the 24:15 mark), Department Treasurers have been trained in the usage of the new application, which was initially made available toward the end of last year but is required as of January 1. You can find it in MALTA or use hard copies, including in the new Join Us brochures.

Checks and cash are still accepted for both annual and Life memberships, and starting January 1, credit cards are, too.

"In the past, we could not accept credit cards for an annual member," says Panteleakos. Now, "If you want to pay yearly with a credit card, you can do that."

"(The application) no longer has a place to put credit card information," explains Barnes, who says that this is the biggest and most important change. "(Department Treasurers) should not be holding on to anyone's credit card information."

If paying by credit card, after this application is processed, an email and/or text message will be sent to the contact information provided in the application for payment. Instructions in the communication for payment must be completed within 30 days (otherwise the application will be voided). If someone other than the applicant above is paying by credit card for the membership, please list the phone number and email address of the payer at the bottom of the application to receive payment instructions once the membership application has been processed.

Why Should I Pay Dues?

"It's so important to pay your dues because we need the numbers in Congress, number one," said Callahan during the HQ Roundtable. "But number two, look, if we don't pay our dues, and if we don't grow this organization, we are going to slowly decline and that will end our ability to exist in general... and we can't have that because if we're not out there advocating for our veterans, if we're not out there teaching patriotism to our youth, if we're not out there visiting hospitals and schools and doing all the things we do... who is going to do it if we don't?"

If you have not yet paid your dues, you are not a member in good standing. If you are not a member in good standing, you cannot attend meetings, hold office or vote. But do not fear – this is fixable! All you have to do is pay your dues ASAP and we offer a number of ways to do so. (Keep in mind, if you still have not paid by June 30, you will lose your membership and have to rejoin, which means re-applying, being voted in again and restarting your years of continuing membership, which impacts your ability to apply for a Continuing Education Scholarship, to receive a Cancer Grant and to be invited to the 45+year members celebration at National Convention.)

A New Way to Pay Dues: By Phone!

You could pay in person before the start of your next meeting by handing cash or a check to your Auxiliary Treasurer, you could pay in MALTA at any time, and, starting January 1, you can also pay over the telephone!
