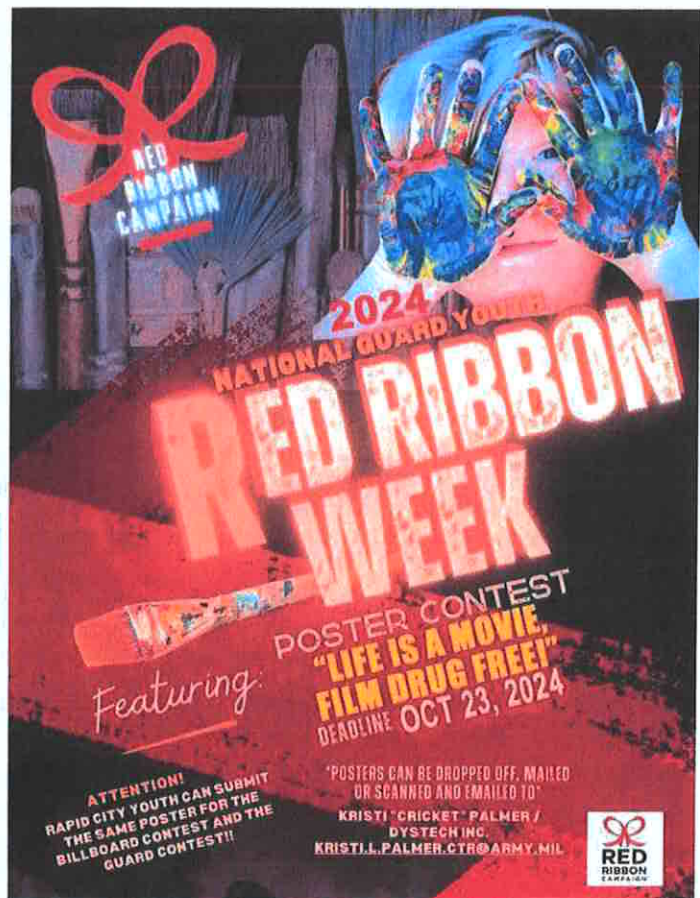

RED RIBBON WEEK IS THE NATION'S OLDEST AND LARGEST DRUG PREVENTION AWARENESS PROGRAM. RED RIBBON WEEK STARTED AFTER THE DEATH OF DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA) SPECIAL AGENT ENRIQUE "KIKI" CAMARENA, WHO IN 1985 WAS BRUTALLY TORTURED AND MURDERED BY DRUG TRAFFICKERS IN MEXICO. AFTER HIS DEATH, PEOPLE STARTED WEARING RED RIBBONS TO HONOR KIKI'S SACRIFICE. TODAY MILLIONS OF PEOPLE CELEBRATE RED RIBBON WEEK BY WEARING RED RIBBONS, PARTICIPATING IN COMMUNITY ANTI-DRUG EVENTS, AND PLEDGING TO LIVE DRUG-FREE LIVES.
