VFW Auxiliary Announces Young American Creative Patriotic Art Scholarship Contest

VFW Auxiliary Department of _____ is excited to announce the kick-off of the VFW Auxiliary's National Young American Creative Patriotic Art Scholarship Contest. The VFW Auxiliary started this contest to recognize young artists and encourage patriotism in youth.

Students in grades 9-12 have the opportunity to compete for one of 23 scholarship placements totaling the amount of \$44,750 in national scholarships. Students must submit an original two-dimensional piece of artwork. The entry must have been completed during the current school year, and the application must include a parent or guardian's signature.

Students begin by competing at the VFW Auxiliary level. The first-place winner from each Auxiliary advances to the Department (state) competition. Department first-place winners advances to the national level for final judging. National winners will be shared on our social media page. An image of national winning entries may be displayed at the VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
